Scabby Mouth is a serious disease, and once it is on a farm, it's there for life. It poses a serious risk to lambs, every season.

This highly contagious disease usually affects lambs during the key period of growth, affecting your ability to finish lambs and reducing your profits.

Infection spreads rapidly and can affect up to 100% of the lamb mob. Scabby mouth is spread by direct contact with infected sheep and lambs, or via contaminated pasture or equipment. Typically abrasive type pastures increase the risk of disease. Vaccination is the only practical way to increase protection for your lambs. It should be an essential part of docking/tailing this, and every spring.

Official Calt Tags

Newborn calves must be tagged with NAIT-approved RFID tags within 180 days of birth, or prior to their first off-farm movement.
