Rat Bait Toxicity

Its winter and with rodents looking to come inside to the warm, many people are using mice and rat baits to prevent infestations. Remember that cats and dogs are just as susceptible to rat bait poisoning as are rats and mice!!


Most rat bait products interfere with vitamin K, a critical component of the blood stream's clotting pathway. Without it, the body can't clot blood, and the animal bleeds internally.

If you suspect that your pet has had access to rat bait, or you catch them "red-pawed", contact the clinic immediately. We can use drugs to make your animal vomit, removing the source of the poison. If you suspect your pet has already absorbed the poison, we can give specific antidotes, and monitor the blood in our own laboratory, ensuring a successful outcome.

Early action is essential. In advanced cases, blood transfusions and several weeks of vitamin K therapy, combined with frequent monitoring, are necessary to avoid fatalities.

Be proactive this winter-prevent access to rat bait toxicity;

- store rat poison securely
- lay bait out of your pet's reach
- use enclosed bait traps

Murphy was visiting the Veterinary Centre for a routine check-up when his owners mentioned that he had quite bad breath. An oral examination revealed he had a bit of a build-up of tartar on his teeth and he was admitted to the hospital to give them a good clean and polish. During this procedure, it was noticed that the gum around one of his molars was a bit inflamed. An x-ray of this tooth revealed an abscess at the root of this tooth meaning it needed to be removed. After his dental, Murphy's owners reported he has

a new lease on life, is playing more, wagging his tail and is generally much happier. They had no idea that he was suffering from chronic pain associated with a tooth root abscess and are amazed at the difference in him. Dental disease is extremely common in our pets and may be the cause of significant pain that goes un-noticed.
