Diabetic Remission in Cats

We often see older cats whose owners have noticed that they are drinking more water. There can be many reasons for a cat to drink more, and early identification of the cause can make a big difference in the course of the individual diseases. This is especially true for Diabetes Mellitus. In cats, Diabetes resembles Type 2 Diabetes in humans. With early identification, appropriate low carbohydrate feeding and insulin treatment, a good

proportion of cats will go into remission and will not need to continue on insulin. This was the case for Anglow. His owners brought him in when they noticed an increase in his thirst and weight loss and he was diagnosed with Diabetes. Anglow's owners were very dedicated with his treatment and he was in remission three months later. He continues on a special diet but has not needed any insulin for six months and he is doing very well.
